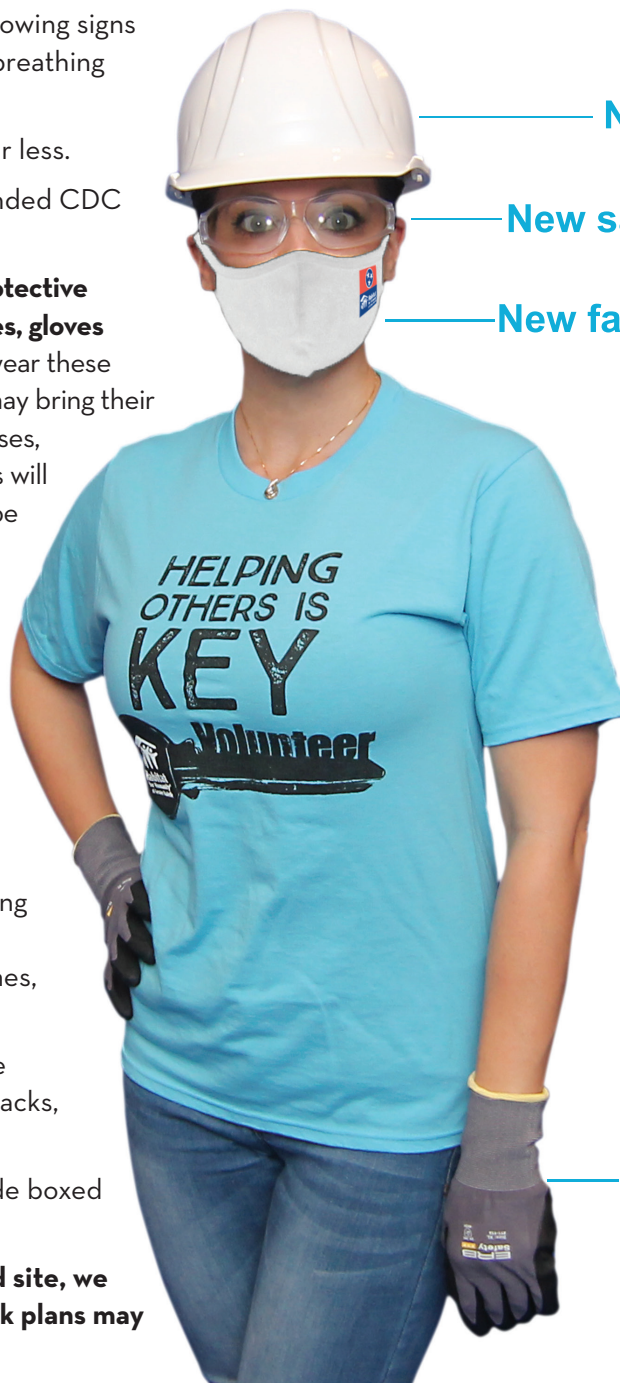




Updated build volunteer group protocols

- Any volunteer or staff member who does not feel well or who is running a temperature, showing signs of acute respiratory illness or difficulty breathing should not come to the build site.
- Volunteers are working in groups of 10 or less.
- Habitat volunteers will follow recommended CDC guidelines for social distancing.
- All volunteers are given **new, personal protective equipment (PPE) - hardhat, safety glasses, gloves and a face covering** and are required to wear these items while on the build site. Volunteers may bring their own face coverings, gloves and safety glasses, personal sunglasses and/or regular glasses will substitute for safety glasses. No PPE will be shared.
- Habitat construction staff and SOS are wearing PPE.
- Hand washing stations and hand sanitizer stations are available at the build site.
- Portalets are cleaned daily.
- Habitat has suspended any large group gatherings like the morning safety meeting and group photo. The safety meeting is conducted at each of the individual homes, in smaller groups.
- Volunteer groups will be asked to designate (2) hospitality volunteers to help with snacks, lunch and water distribution.
- Volunteer groups will be asked to provide boxed lunches instead of buffet style food.
- **To maintain a safe and productive build site, we invite your flexibility as some build/task plans may change from an original assignment.**
